Junior, Senior I & II List:

Dance Attire:

Ladies:

- Pink tights *convertible*
- Black stirrup tights
- Solid color leotard
- Black ballet skirt
- Black Jazz pants
- Pink Ballet shoes (canvas or leather-elastics need to be sewn)
- Pointe Shoes (ribbons need to be sewn)
- Jazz boots color suntan or flesh. (If taking jazz for fall)
- Tap shoes black leather with laces. NO SPLIT SOLE (If taking tap for fall)
- Black character shoes for Flamenco (Sr I & II only)
- Pink ballet trunks
- Black ballet trunks
- Flesh color under-over
- Flesh thong (Sr I & II only)

Gentleman:

- Black tights and solid colored T-shirt
- White socks
- Black and white ballet shoes (canvas)
- Black Jazz shoes (If taking jazz for fall)
- Tap shoes black leather with tie (If taking tap for fall)
- Dance Belt

Make up and earrings:

- Standard stage makeup
 - o Foundation/Pancake foundation
 - o Liquid waterproof eyeliner or black pencil
 - o Blush for contour (earthy tone)
 - o Blush for apples of cheeks (pink/peach tone)

- o Mauve tone eyeshadows
- o Fake eyelashes (Black)
- o Eyelash glue dark tone in tube
- o Earth Red lipstick
- o Eye makeup remover
- o Face cleanser/Wash cloth

- Rhinestone earrings (If ears not pierced get clip-ons)
 - o Studs
 - o Size of a "pea"

Hair supplies:

- Brush/comb
- Hair elastics (good to buy the ones that are the same color of hair. It will be needed for future performances)
- Hairnet (comes in packs of three at any drugstore, again color of hair)
- Hairpins (They get lost throughout the year)
- Headband for students who have bangs. (They have some that have a grip to them. Helps stay on their head when they turn)
- Small travel size hairspray (Plastic dispenser, preferably)

Health/wellness needs:

- Deodorant (according to need)
- Small container of hand sanitizer
- 100 band-aids
- Antibiotic cream (neosporin)
- Feminine Hygiene products (according to need)
- Needle & thread
- 10 safety pins
- Hand towel
- Stretch band (*thera band-medium resistance*)
- Tennis Ball
- Water bottle (small packets of powdered vitamin enhancements)
- Sports/power bars and/or dried fruit
